By working with care coordinators, the HUB helps individuals and families in the tri-county area to identify needs and connect them to resources to help them live healthy lives.

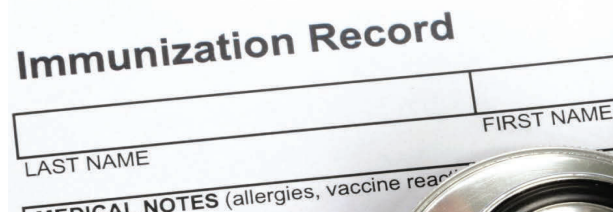
