

## Community Outreach Worker

Part-Time (up to 28 hours/week)

This position serves as the neighborhood navigator connecting Mahoning County's most at-risk pregnant women to the prenatal health, behavioral health and social services they need to have a healthy pregnancy and deliver a healthy newborn infant. The Community Outreach Worker educates the community about infant mortality prevention programs and services available in Mahoning County. Must have earned a High School Diploma or GED; must have knowledge of the at-risk communities experiencing disproportionate rates of infant mortality across Mahoning County; must have experience in working in a multi-cultural setting. Must be able to work with an interdisciplinary team; must be culturally, linguistically and socially aware; must be able to work with diverse populations; must be able to communicate clearly in verbal and written format; must have basic computer skills; must have a valid driver's license; and automobile liability insurance coverage. Successful completion of a Community Health Worker certified by one of the Ohio Board of Nursing Approved Community Health Worker Training Programs as set forth in Chapter 4723.82 of Ohio Administrative Code is preferred.
