Mahoning County Public Health to Offer Rabies and Flu Vaccination Clinics

*Rabies Vaccination for dogs, cats, and ferrets and
Flu Shots for anyone over the age of 6 months
will be offered at Angels for Animals on Sunday, November 3*

In Mahoning County, rabies vaccination is required for all dogs, cats, and ferrets over 3 months of age. Cost is \$8.00 per rabies shot (cash only). Pet owners must have their pets on a leash, in a cage, or carried inside a pillowcase. This is a low-cost clinic that does not include a physical examination of the animal. The veterinary staff reserves the right not to vaccinate any animal in the event the animal appears to be in poor health. To receive the 3-year booster, bring proof of prior rabies vaccination on or after November 3, 2018. Without proof of prior vaccination, the pet will receive a 1-year vaccination only.

Flu shots are recommended for anyone over the age of 6 months and people at high risk of developing flu-related complications. Please bring insurance cards, driver's license, Medicaid and Medicare cards so that cost of the vaccine can be billed; most private insurances are accepted. With proof of insurance the flu vaccine is free. The Quadrivalent (4 flu virus strains) flu vaccine is available for ages 6 months and up and the high dose trivalent (3 flu strains) is available for those 65 years of age and older.

No appointments are necessary for either clinic.
