Drinking Water Testing Available for Village of Sebring Public Water System Customers

In collaboration with the Village of Sebring, the Mahoning County District Board of Health Laboratory is offering lead testing for residents who receive drinking water from the Village of Sebring Public Water System. This test is at no cost to the customer. Residents who wish to have their water tested can stop by the Village of Sebring Municipal Building to pick up sampling bottles. The sampling bottles will include detailed instructions on how to collect the water sample. Water testing will be available until further notice.

Residents may pick up bottles at the Village of Sebring Municipal Building Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

The samples must then be dropped off at the Village of Sebring Municipal Building on Mondays or Wednesdays no later than 10:00 a.m.

The lead results will be provided to the residents via email. A paper copy will also be provided to the Village of Sebring. If residents do not have an email address, a paper copy of the report can be obtained from the Village of Sebring Municipal Building.
