## Second Blood Lead Screening Clinic Scheduled

A Blood Lead Screening Clinic is scheduled for area residents from birth to six years of age and pregnant or breastfeeding women that receive drinking water from the Village of Sebring Public Water System.

The Blood Lead Screening Clinic will take place:

This initial screening test is done by a finger-stick and is free of charge. No appointment is necessary. If the initial screening test shows an elevated blood lead level, follow up testing with a primary care provider will be required.

This screening clinic is being conducted in response to the report of elevated levels of lead in drinking water at some locations served by Village of Sebring.

Lead can cause serious health problems for pregnant women, infants, and children. Pregnant and breastfeeding women, infants, and children who source of drinking water is the Village of Sebring Public Water System are advised to use bottled water for cooking, drinking, and baby formula preparation.
