*Rabies vaccination for all dogs, cats, and ferrets over 3 months of age is required in Mahoning County.*

- No appointment is necessary for the clinic.
- This is a low-cost clinic that does not include a physical examination of the animal.
- **Cost is \$6 per shot, cash only.**
- Pet owners must have their pets on a leash, in a cage, or carried in a cloth pillowcase.
- The Veterinary staff reserves the right not to vaccinate any animal in the event the animal appears to be in poor health.

*Did you know?*

- Rabies is a deadly disease transmitted in saliva.
- Cats and dogs are infected with rabies by wild animals every year.
- Bites from unvaccinated pets and stray animals could cause human exposure to rabies.
- Rabies IS a preventable disease!

**Protect yourself, your family, and pets from rabies:**

- Vaccinate all dogs, cats and ferrets against rabies.
- Avoid contact with wildlife and stray animals.
- If bitten, wash the wound thoroughly and see your doctor.
