# *IT'S THIS EASY TO PICK UP RABIES!*



*Did you know?*

- *Rabies is a deadly disease transmitted in saliva.*
- *Cats and dogs are infected with rabies by wild animals every year.*
- *Bites from unvaccinated pets, strays, and wildlife could cause human exposure to rabies.*
- *Rabies IS a preventable disease!*

***Protect yourself, your pets and your family :***

- *Vaccinate your pets.*
- *Maintain control of your pets to reduce their exposure to wildlife.*
- *Spay or neuter to decrease the number of stray animals.*
- *Avoid contact with wildlife and stray animals.*
- *Wash any animal bite areas thoroughly and follow up with a doctor.*
